### Invotech gets fit with Jackie Skelly Fitness gym chain

Irish software provider Invotech has won a €200,000 deal with the Jackie Skelly Fitness gym chain to install its point of sale solution, Club Organiser, in all seven of its gyms.

Under the terms of the contract, which was signed last August, Invotech will also install the software in four new Jackie Skelly gyms due to open before the end of 2008, including a gym in Drogheda, Co Louth, which opens next month.

The system's functionality includes member subscriptions, facility bookings, point of sale, access control and management reporting and uses hardware by Dublin-based retail IT distributor **PC Cubed**.

"Club Organiser was designed to be easy, fast and accurate," said Peter O'Neill, managing director of Invotech. "The system offers quick member check-in with the latest scanning technology the Quantum, crucial at peak times. The software also has the capability to collect monthly direct debits from Irish banks.

"Staff can view customer details using key rings or key tag swipes, member photo capture, renewal reminders, health conditions alerts and recent usage stats."

Established in 1999, Invotech employs five staff and has a turnover of €400,000. O'Neill said the company was undergoing significant growth.

"We are growing at a rate of 25 per cent per annum and recently moved into new premises in Blackglan Village Centre in Sandymount," he said.

"We have taken on three staff members to cater for the growth, and we have added several new products to our software suite since 1999 including Booking Organiser, Security Organiser for turnstile and door access control, point of sale organiser, spa manager, texting organiser and loyalty organiser."
